

THE MUSIC THERAPY ASSESSMENT PROCESS:

1. Completed by the Harrison Center's music therapists.

Only professionals who have earned the credentials Music Therapist-Board Certified (MT-BC) can complete music therapy assessments. HCMT therapists have also completed additional education and advanced trainings.

2. Assesses non-music goal areas.

Music therapy assessments are designed to outline and evaluate the following domain areas along with other clinicians on a patient's team: Cognition, Social, Emotional, Communication, Sensory and Motor skills.

3. Measures and compares music to non-music functioning levels.

Responses to music and non musical interventions are measured to see if music therapy is an effective treatment for each new potential patient.

4. Develop treatment goals.

If the assessment determines that music therapy may be effective, results are used to develop measurable goals for ongoing treatment.
